Attendance and Apologies

ASIO Site in Campbell

Leon Advised that ASIO had provided information about its proposal to store fuel at its site on Constitution Avenue, but did not offer to provide a speaker on the topic.

Hackett Community Association

The four Committee members present confirmed the agreement to contribute \$150 towards the cost of a Hackett Community Association sausage sizzle at a Community event that is being planned for May.

A discussion ensued on the relative merits of funding community associations to produce their own brochures (which could include information about the North Canberra Community Council) or of producing a North Canberra Community Council brochure which would include information about north Canberra's community associations.

Discussion

Angie Drake introduced herself as an ACT Labor candidate for the seat of Molonglo. There followed a discussion of election-related issues that affect North Canberra residents, including:

- Aircraft noise
- What types of building works should be exempt from Development Applications, and the process for appealing against Development Applications
- Traffic issues, especially dealing with the increasing level of traffic that passes through North Canberra suburbs on its way to and from Gungahlin.
- Management of the Canberra Nature Park the need for adequate funding and staffing, and the proposed Centennial Trail that has highlighted the need for a study of the Park's recreational carrying capacity, to help identify an appropriate balance between recreational use and nature conservation.
- Open Government, and the issue of whether the next ACT Government will continue to openly consult on issues that affect the community.
- Smarter Canberra planning for the future, including climate change.

Bruce agreed to locate a copy of the letter that invited election candidates to our election forum for the previous election, and to either use it as a basis for a new invitation letter or pass it to Leon.
