There will be further impacts from ongoing residential developments in Gungahlin and north Watson which feed into Ainslie and north Canberra suburbs. Recent traffic counts show that the new lights at the intersection of Philip Avenue and Majura Avenue cannot put through any more traffic in morning peak hour. We have been led to believe that construction of the Morisset Road connection from Sandford Street, Mitchell to Northbourne Avenue and Antill Street has been mothballed for the time being. Wells Station Road on the EPIC side of Northbourne Avenue is being used as an alternate detour by trucks and other vehicles to avoid the lights on Flemington Road.
